IMPORTANT INFORMATION!!!

Clubs start week beginning Monday 8th September 2025 through to Friday 17th October and begin again after half term from Monday 3rd November through to Friday 5th December 2025. **PLEASE NOTE THAT THERE ARE NO CLUBS ON THE FIRST AND LAST WEEK OF TERM.**

Please note that all clubs will be offered on a first come, first served basis. If you are unsuccessful in gaining a place for your child on any of the limited clubs and would like your child to be put on the waiting list please email the school office.

We kindly ask that you submit your requests for activities, both free and chargeable, via your child's WisePay account. WisePay will only allow you to book places if they are available, so you are guaranteed a place as soon as you have booked. You will not receive a booking confirmation, so please print off the back of this leaflet, list your child's chosen clubs and keep this for your records.

Please note that any requests that are not booked through WisePay may not be acknowledged.

Whilst we understand that children do change their minds, the clubs that are chargeable and run by external providers, budget for the numbers that we provide them with at the start of the term. If your child signs up for a club that incurs a costs and then decides that they no longer wish to attend, then unfortunately, you will be liable to pay the fees for the whole term. The same costs would apply if your child joins a club at a later stage during the term - subject to availability.

Please make sure that your child's club requests are submitted via WisePay by **NO LATER THAN MIDNIGHT** on Sunday 7th September. After this point WisePay will close and you will no longer be able to submit your child's request. This may result in your child not gaining a place in their preferred clubs.

Please note that if your child is attending a club, they should not be picked up before the club ends

Our drum teacher Mr Clark will be leading a percussion group.


You do not need to be learning percussion to attend, just enjoy playing classroom percussion instruments together.

Code Club | Tuesday | 4:00pm - 5:00pm Years 3-6



We will be using low compression tennis balls, the tennis net is a little lower and smalle rackets are used. The sessions are based on a little bit of technique and an introduction to match play.



ADVANCED Judo | Friday | 4:45pm - 5:30pm Years 3-6


