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Our school traces its roots back across almost ten centuries, to the founding of the Lincoln Minster chorister school.



Since that time, the school – and the Cathedral – have flourished together, side by side in the heart of our historic city. Our relationship with the cathedral continues to this day. The history of Lincoln also features periods of Roman and Viking occupation, and it was William the Conqueror himself who first ordered the construction of Lincoln Castle in 1068. The historic centre of Lincoln, steps away from our school campus, is an inspirational environment for curious, thoughtful young people to learn and grow.

# Built on... *opportunity*

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It is only by trying new things that pupils can learn about themselves, and discover what drives them.

Our extensive co-curricular programme encourages pupils to try activities ranging from sailing to robotics, and from molecular gastronomy to knitting – but that's just the start.



In the Senior School, pupils have the opportunity to try over 100 different co-curricular clubs during and after the school day. Clubs are delivered by a range of teaching colleagues and some excellent external coaches who spend time getting to know every child as an individual. Partnerships with the city's Bishop Grosseteste and Lincoln Universities allow senior pupils to attend undergraduate lectures, and make use of the Lincoln University library. Trips and visits –

from cultural day trips to challenging adventures – introduce new cultures and ideas; recent destinations have included Colorado, Peru and Madrid.

From their first day in Reception until their final days in Year 13, exploration and discovery are encouraged for every pupil.

Our scholarship programme supports even greater development in sport, music, art, drama and academic learning.







# Built on... *endeavour*

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Teamwork, communication, testing ourselves to the limit – our sports programme develops the qualities and attitudes for a happy, successful life.



Whether in athletics, badminton, archery, cross country running, dance, gymnastics, swimming, table tennis, equestrian, tennis, volleyball, rowing, squash, rugby, football, hockey, ballet, judo, yoga, rounders, sailing or cricket, there are options both for talented individuals who have particular interests, and equally for those whose motivation is more recreational and social.

Sport is for everyone: we ensure that children of all abilities and aptitudes have a positive experience and learn to appreciate the enjoyment and benefits to be gained from physical activity.

In addition to our excellent on-site facilities, we enjoy access to high-quality specialist facilities through our partner organisations, including exclusive use of the Lindum all-weather hockey pitch during school days and on Saturday mornings; all-weather courts at Eastgate Tennis Club, and sailing and equestrian facilities.

Sport scholarships are available.

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The Arts have been a vital part of school life since our earliest beginnings, as the Cathedral School for Lincoln Minster. Today, our choirs are part of an inspirational music programme that ranges from classical to jazz and rock, with learning and co-curricular options from Reception to Sixth Form. Pupils benefit from a beautiful modern recital hall, practice rooms and a music technology suite.



From Shakespeare to the nativity, we offer an exceptional performing arts programme. Whether pupils choose to take on performance, technical or design roles, by working together on productions every individual grows in confidence and professionalism. The LAMDA programme is available for Prep and Senior pupils.

Led by teachers who are also passionate, highly skilled practicing artists, our Art Department supports the exploration of creativity and personal expression across fine art, graphic design, textiles and photography. Excellent facilities – including, for senior students, unparalleled views across the historic cityscape – provide an inspirational environment.

Scholarships are available in art, drama and music.

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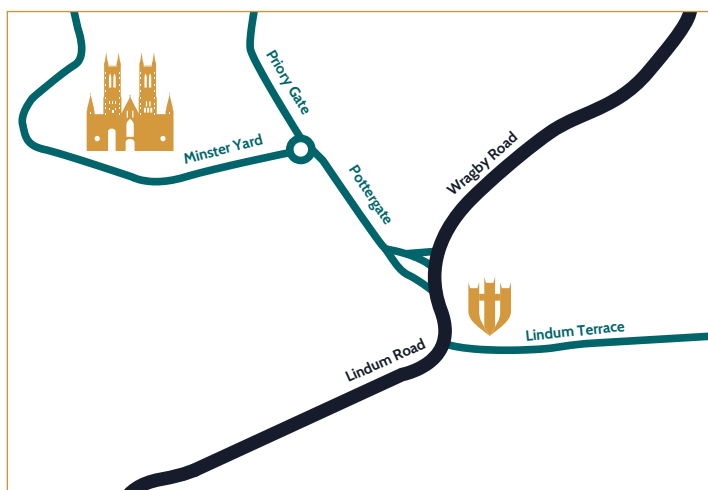
## Getting here
