Upon completion, our pupils will be further prepared for:







# **REQUIREMENTS &** ADMISSIONS

#### COURSE REQUIRMENTS

Entry to the Level 3 BTEC National Extended Diploma in Sport requires candidates to have a minimum of five GCSEs at grades 9-4 (A\*- C), including English and Maths, in order to access the full academy schedule.

We require our students to have attained a handicap index of 9.9 or below using the WHS (World Handicap System).

Management will consider students on an individual basis both academically and level of golf experience and success.

#### ADMISSIONS

This exciting course is available to golfers from all four corners of the United Kingdom as well as from Europe and the rest of the world.
